4. What is it that keeps you from being more intentional and open to connection with the casual interactions in your life?
5. What is one intentional choice you could make to increase your casual connection? (Think of your own answer, or choose one from the slide in this weekend's message)
 - a. Prioritize the "in-person" connection
 - b. Smile and make eye contact
 - c. Be curious, but keep it light.
 - d. Be open to the unexpected positive.
